3.
$$f(x) = \sqrt{x+1}, x \in [3,8].$$

4.
$$f(x) = \frac{1}{2\sqrt{x+1}}, x \in [0,8].$$

5.
$$f(x) = (2x^2 + 1)^2, x \in [0,1].$$

6. Draw a diagram and find the area of that portion of the first quadrant which is bounded above by $-x^2 + 8$ and bounded below by $y = x^2$.
